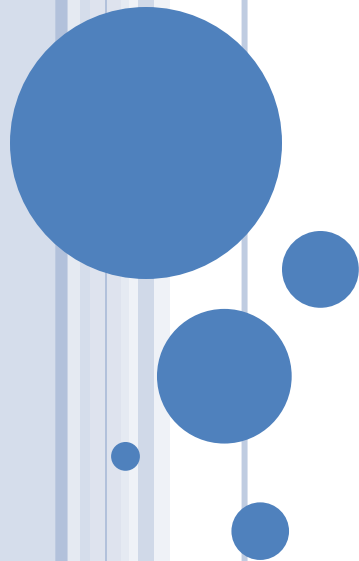

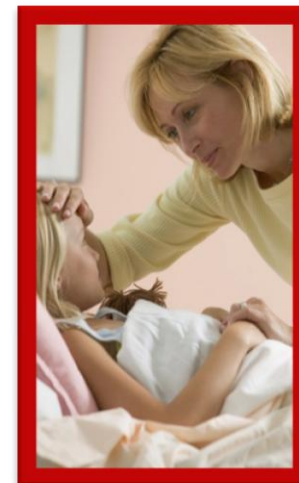


Three red hearts

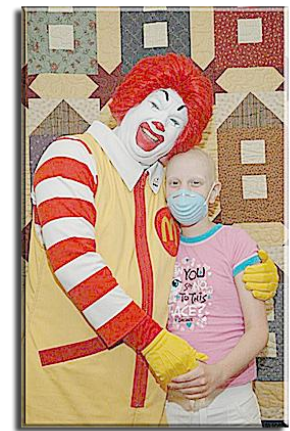


Joining Forces with the Ronald McDonald House

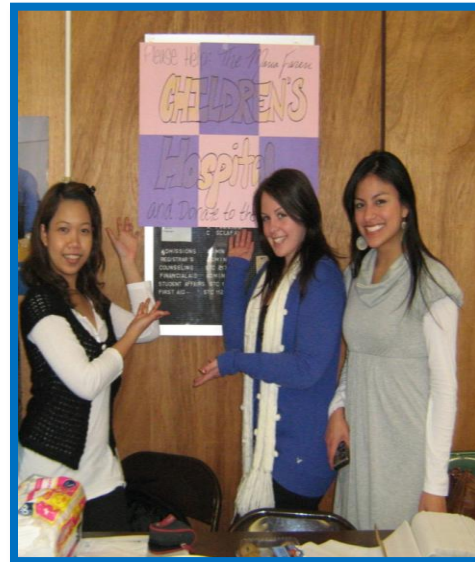
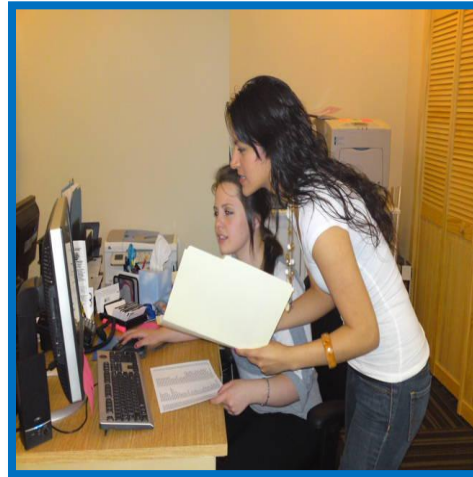

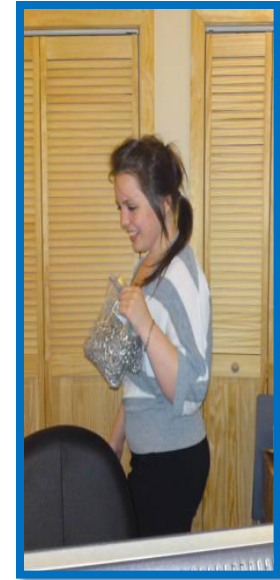
Activities We Have Taken Part In
